PERMANANT REMOVAL OF BEACON NO 10 CORIO CHANNEL, PORT OF GEELONG

**Date:** 1 October 2015

**Previous Notices** No 170 (T)-2015 refers and is hereby cancelled

**Details:** Mariners are advised that as part of the Geelong Channel Safety Improvement Works program, **Beacon No 10** in the Corio Channel (ALL K 2309) will be permanently removed on or about October 5/6 2015. Elstone Diving Services will be on site with the **JACK DANIEL** crane barge and the motor launch **MUNDU** for the removal in daylight hours only. A minimum distance of 100 meters must be maintained by all passing vessels.

The removal craft will keep a listening watch on Channel 12 and may be contacted on 0419 865 987 if needed.

Mariners are reminded vide this Notice that the port hand **Buoy No 10** presently in position East of Beacon No 10 should be kept on the port hand whilst accessing Refinery piers inwards. On completion of the dredging works later in the month Buoy No 10 will also be removed permanently.
