Date: Between 4 June 2010 and 18 June 2010

Previous Notice: 054 (T) - 10 is referred and cancelled

Details: Mariners are advised of pile driving and jetty reinstatement works at Queenscliff Harbour at approximate location 38°15.82'S 144°40.18'E (WGS84).

Floating plant (including barges and workboat) will be operating during the day and anchored at night. Anchors will be marked by buoys. Barges and workboats will be lit from sunset to sunrise to IALA standards. During the works the creek will be closed for 2 hours on ebb tides. Emergency access will be permitted.

Mariners are advised to navigate with a speed commensurate with safe navigation in the vicinity of floating plant and equipment
