MAINTENANCE DREDGE WORKS AT PORTARLINGTON HARBOUR

Date: From 15 June 2010 to 29 June 2010, weather dependant

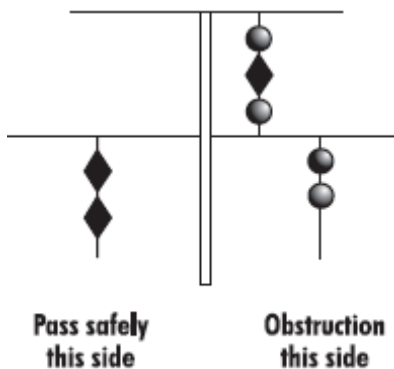
Details: Mariners are advised that maintenance dredging operations will be carried out at Portarlington Harbour at the approximate location 38°6.607'S, 144°39.205' E (WGS 84).

Dredging spoil will be deposited on the adjacent foreshore to the west of the Harbour. Dredging operations will be carried out during day light hours.

Dredging works will be carried out by a cutter suction dredge, where all hazards to boating, including floating plant and equipment, will be marked appropriately to IALA standards.

All Vessels are advised to proceed at a safe speed and observe the day marks displayed on the dredge.

All vessel operators are requested to pass on the side displaying two diamonds or await instructions before passing on the side displaying two black balls.
