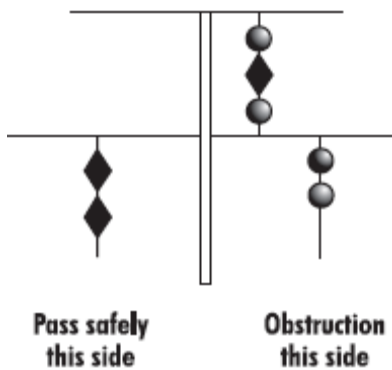

MAINTENANCE DREDGE

Date: Between 28 June 2010 and 1 December 2010

Details: Mariners are advised of Maintenance Dredging operations by Royal Brighton Yacht Club at approximate location 37°54.312' S, 144°58.895' E (WGS84).

Dredging Spoil will be deposited at a Designated Offshore Spoil Ground at approximate location 37°54'29.776 S, 144°58'12.802 E (WGS84). Dredging Operations will be carried out during day light hours.



Dredging works will be carried out by Cutter Suction Dredge "Eva K". All on water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation, at both dredge ground and Designated Offshore Spoil Ground, will be marked appropriately to IALA standards.

All Vessels Operators are advised to proceed at a safe speed and observe the day marks displayed on the dredge.

All vessel operators are requested to pass on the side displaying two diamonds or await instructions before passing on the side displaying two black balls.
