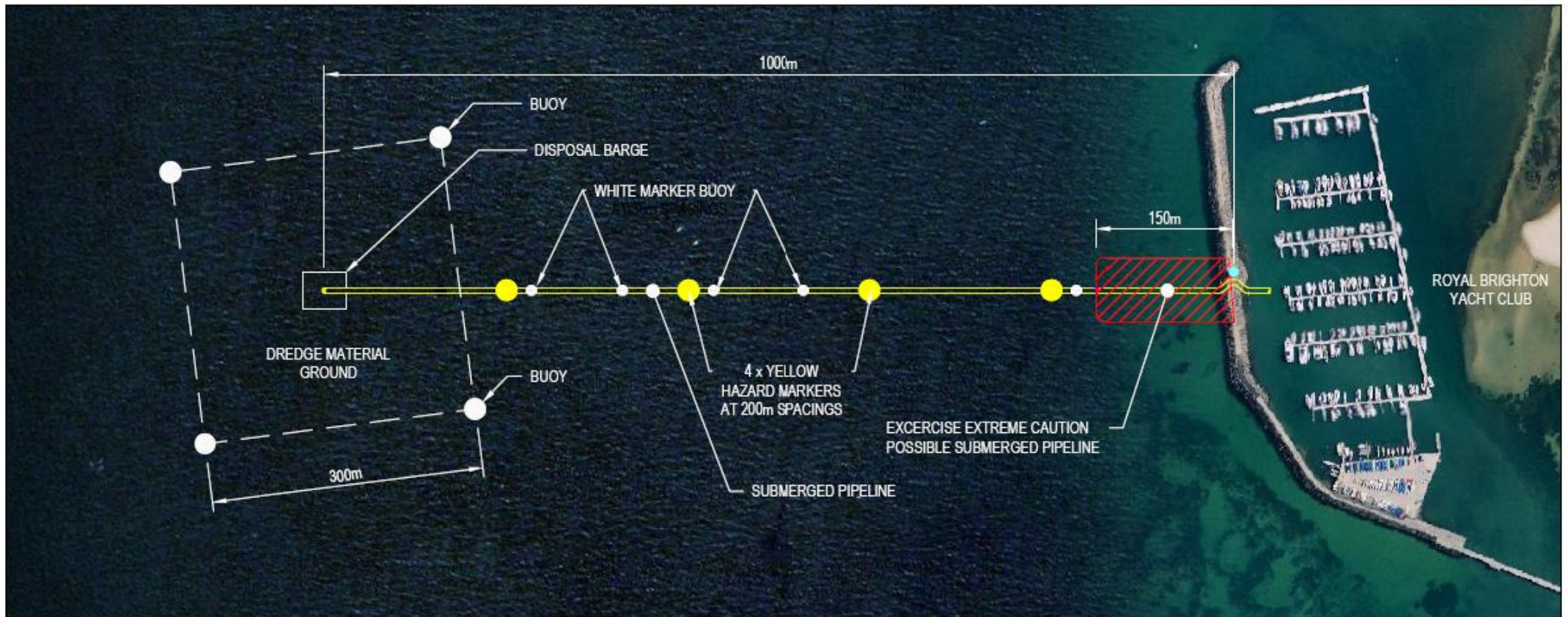

DREDGE MARKINGS UPDATE

- Date:** Between 05 August 2010 and 01 December 2010
- Previous Notice:** Notice 064T – 2010 is referred.
- Details:** Mariners are advised of continuing maintenance dredging operations at approximate location 37°54.312' S, 144°58.895' E (WGS84).
- Dredging spoil will be deposited via pipeline to a designated offshore spoil ground at approximate location 37°54'29.776 S, 144°58'12.802 E (WGS84), approximately 1000m west of the breakwater. The barge at disposal ground is marked with a yellow light, flashing every 3 seconds.
- The pipeline is marked approximately every 36m with white buoys and 4 hazard markers with yellow lights flashing every 3 seconds (see attached image).
- All vessel operators are advised to proceed at a safe speed and observe the day marks displayed on the dredge.**
- Navigate with extreme caution within 150m of the breakwater due to the possible presence of a semi-submerged pipeline.**
