The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

PORT OF BARWON HEADS

BARWON RIVER, TEMPORARY SUBMARINE PIPELINE, BARWON HEADS

BOATING EXCLUSION ZONE

Date: 14th September 2010 - With immediate effect.

Details: Mariners are advised that a boating exclusion zone has been gazetted around the location of a temporary submarine pipeline across the Barwon River.

Marine Safety Victoria, under subsection 15(1) of the Marine Act 1988 has declared a Barwon River Exclusion Zone, copy of Section 15 Notice Attached.

Coe Drilling P/L pipeline construction contractor for Barwon Water Alliance will be installing special mark buoys to define the alignment of the submarine pipeline within the exclusion zone to provide for safety of waterway users while construction works are undertaken.

Lateral mark buoys with lights will be installed to define the permitted transit lane through the exclusion zone. Mariners will be able to pass freely through this transit lane except when red flags are mounted on the lateral marks as mariners approach from upstream or downstream.

A map of the waterway exclusion zone with transit lane is provided with this notice.

At the main boat ramps on the river bank upstream of the construction works, a sign is provided to illustrate the transit lane through the exclusion zone.

Construction work requirements will from time to time require the short term closure of the transit lane, at these times Mariners will not be permitted to travel through the exclusion zone. Mariners will be asked to hold while the construction works are stopped and made safe then Mariners will be directed to proceed.

At all times Mariners are expected to observe the instructions of the construction contractor for safe passage through the exclusion zone while works are in progress.

Advice will be provided to Mariners by works contractors when the short term closures are likely to occur, signage will be placed at the main boat ramps in Barwon Heads and Ocean Grove.

Mariners are advised to exercise caution when navigating in the area.

**Marine Act 1988
Section 15 Notice**

I, Diane Julie Bates, the Director Marine Safety (as delegate of the Director, Transport Safety) on the recommendation of Warren Chapman, Manager Natural Resource Planning, Barwon Coast Committee of Management Inc. (the Waterway Manager for the Designated Port of Barwon Heads) hereby give notice under Section 15(1) of the **Marine Act 1988**, that:

1. from 7.00 am Wednesday 15 September 2010 till 6.00 pm Friday 5 November 2010 bathing and the operation of vessels (including anchoring, mooring or allowing a vessel to lie) excluding those vessels involved with the Barwon River drilling project is prohibited on the waters within the exclusion zone as detailed in Table 1. Vessels wishing to transit the exclusion zone may do so via a channel marked with port and starboard lateral marks except for the times when red flags are displayed on port and starboard lateral marks on the upstream and downstream approaches to the exclusion zone.

Table 1: Barwon River Exclusion Zone

The waters bounded by:

- (i) A line extending from a point on shore 38° 16' 30.48" S, 144° 29' 48.34" E; to a point on the shore 38° 16' 32.04" S, 144° 29' 47.81" E
- (ii) A line extending from a point on the shore 38° 16' 32.04" S, 144° 29' 47.81" E; to a point on the shore 38° 16' 36.125" S, 144° 30' 05.47" E;
- (iii) A line extending from a point on the shore 38° 16' 36.125" S, 144° 30' 05.47" E to a point on the shore 38° 16'.34.76" S 144° 30'06.96" E
- (iv) A line extending from a point on the shore 38° 16'.34.76" S 144° 30'06.96" E to a point on the shore 38° 16' 30.48" S, 144° 29' 48.34" E

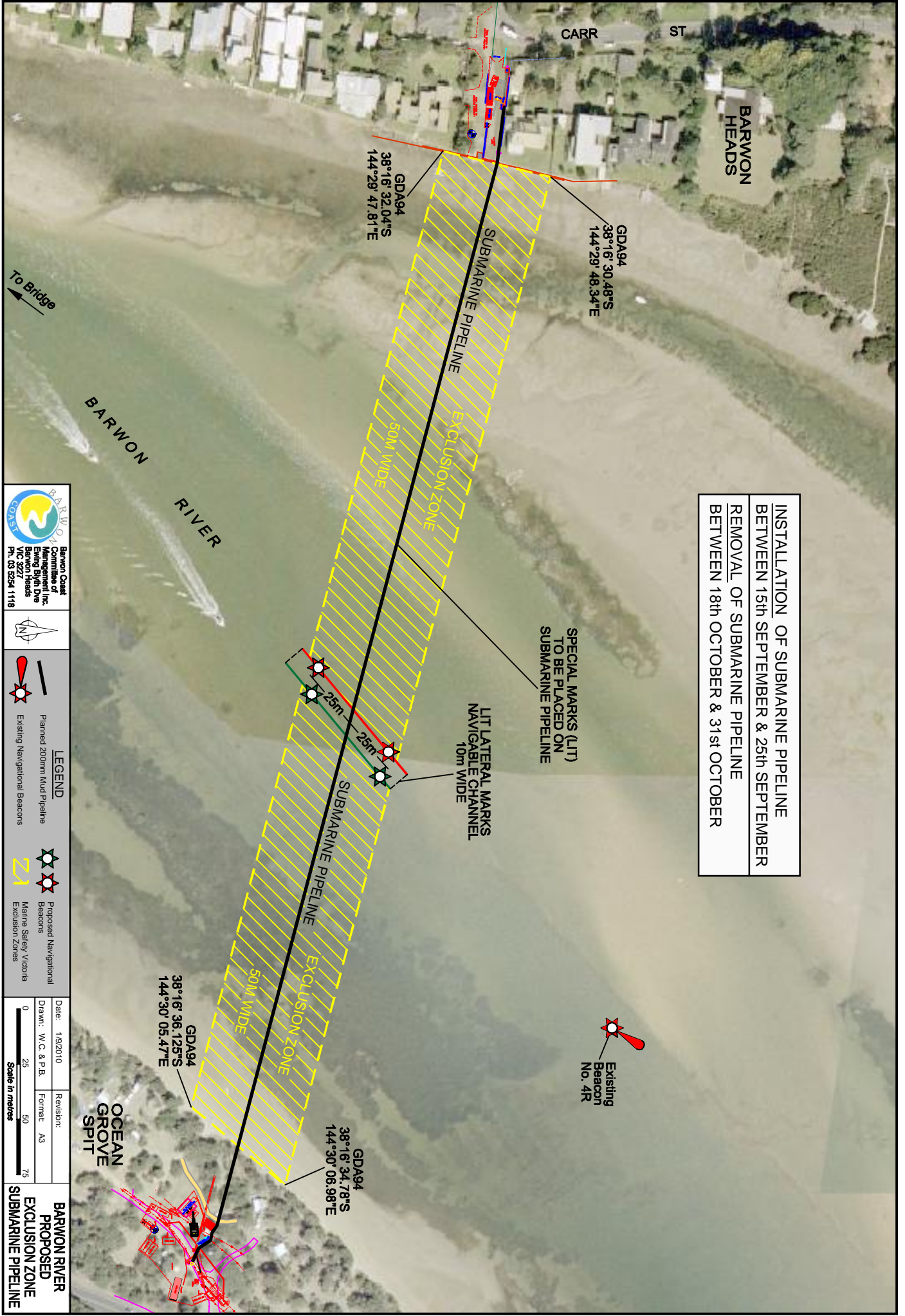
