Details: Mariners are advised that new Special Marks piles have been installed approximately 200m from mean low water mark between Station Pier, Port Melbourne and St Kilda Harbour. Redundant piles and buoys previously in place have been removed.

A new Isolated Danger pile has been installed at approx. 37° 51.303' S, 144° 57.338' E (WGS 84) to mark Magpie reef.

Ongoing works will continue to be carried out by Elstone Diving Services Pty Ltd.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of the continuing works.
