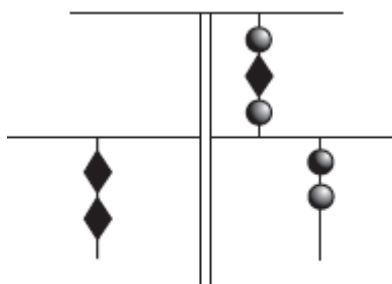
MORDIALLOC CREEK ENTRANCE

MAINTENANCE DREDGING

Date: Between 20 October 2010 and 30 October 2010

Details: Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging works by Parks Victoria at Mordialloc Creek at approximate location 38° 0.696' S, 145° 05.026' E (WGS84).

The dredge will be operating in the entrance channel to Mordialloc Creek. Dredge material is to be deposited for beach renourishment to the east of the entrance.

All on water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation will be marked with flashing yellow hazard lights from sunset to sunrise.

All Vessels Operators are advised to proceed at a safe speed and observe the day marks displayed on the dredge.

All vessel operators are requested to pass on the side displaying two diamonds or await instructions before passing on the side displaying two black balls.
