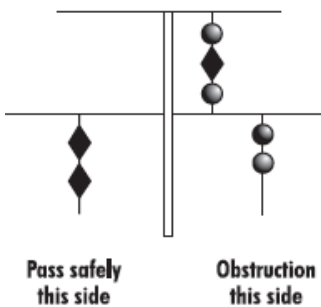

MAINTENANCE DREDGING AT MOTHERS BEACH

Date: Between 02 November 2010 and 24 November 2010

Details: Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging work by Mornington Shire Council at approximate location 38° 12.825 S, 145° 2.067 E (WGS84).



The dredge will be operating in front of Mothers Beach Boat Ramp with dredge material being deposited on Mothers Beach for renourishment.

All on water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation will be marked with flashing yellow hazard lights from sunset to sunrise.

All Vessels Operators are advised to proceed at a safe speed and observe the day marks displayed on the dredge.

All vessel operators are requested to pass on the side displaying two diamonds or await instructions before passing on the side displaying two black balls.
