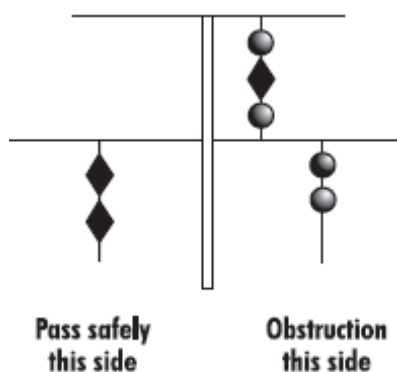
QUEENSCLIFF

SWING MOORING BASIN & QUEENSCLIFF CUT

MAINTENANCE DREDGING

Date: Between 15 November 2010 and 4 December 2010

Details: Mariners are advised of dredging works by Parks Victoria at Queenscliff mooring area and cut at approximate location 38° 15.686' S, 144° 39.987' E (WGS84).



The dredge will be operating between Queenscliff Cruising Yacht Club and Swan Island Bridge and also in The Cut opposite Fishermans Wharf to remove the sand spit.

Vessels normally moored in this area will be temporarily berthed alongside the QCYC Wharf and within the Queenscliff Harbour.

All on water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation will be marked with flashing yellow hazard lights from sunset to sunrise.

All Vessels Operators are advised to proceed at a safe speed and observe the day marks displayed on the dredge.

All vessel operators are requested to pass on the side displaying two diamonds or await instructions before passing on the side displaying two black balls.
