MAINTENANCE DREDGING – ROUTINE CAPPING OF DREDGED MATERIAL

Date: Effective on or about 18 November 2010 until 17 December 2010.

Details: Mariners are advised that routine capping of dredged material at the Port of Melbourne DMG is due to commence on or about 18 November 2010 and continue until 17 December 2010. This will complete the 2009 -2011 Maintenance Dredging Program.

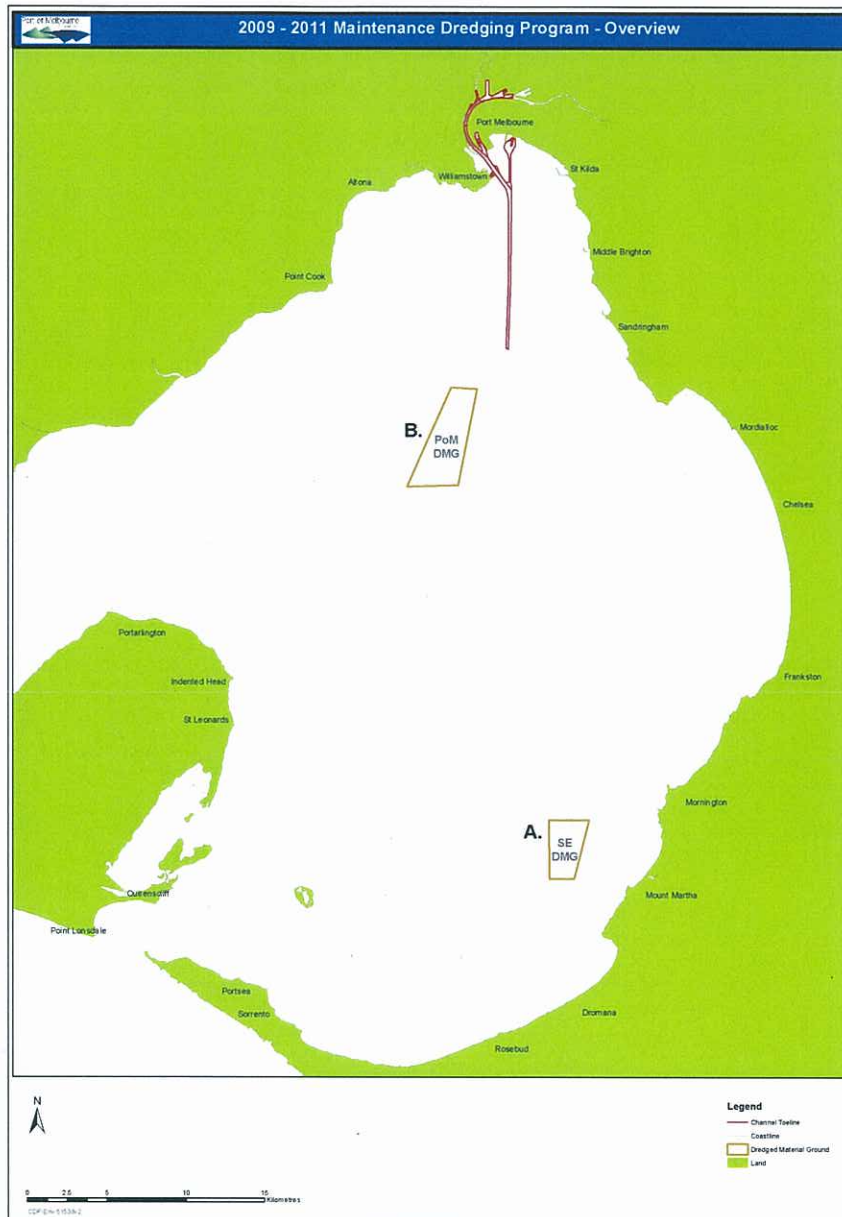
The dredging operation will be conducted by the trailing suction hopper dredge, *Cornelis Zanen*, and is expected to continue 24 hours per day seven days per week.

The works will involve relocating clean sand from the SEDMG (location A on the accompanying plan) and using it to cap the PoMDMG (location B on the plan).

Updated information on the location of the dredge can be obtained from *Melbourne VTS* or *Lonsdale VTS* on VHF channel 12.

Cornelis Zanen can also be contacted on VHF channel 12.

Mariners are advised to proceed with caution when navigating in the vicinity of the capping operations.
