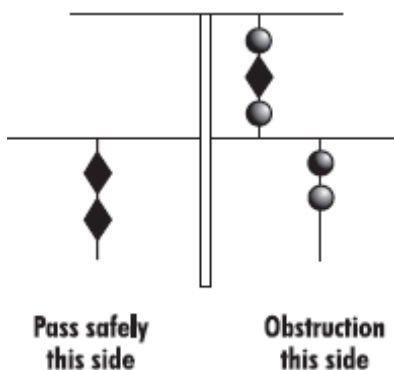
PORT PHILLIP

RYE BOAT RAMP

Date: Between 22 November 2010 and 28 January 2011

Details: Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging works being carried out by Mornington Peninsula Shire Council at approximate location 38° 22.080 S, 144° 49.235 E (WGS84).



Dredging is to be carried out by a cutter suction barge which will be operating in the approach channel to Rye boat ramp in front of the car park.

Dredge spoil will be transported by pipe along the shore line and placed on the beach for renourishment at approximate location 38° 22.136' S, 144° 49.462' E.

All on water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation will be marked with flashing yellow hazard lights from sunset to sunrise.

All Vessels Operators are advised to proceed at a safe speed and observe the day marks displayed on the dredge.

All vessel operators are requested to pass on the side displaying two diamonds or await instructions before passing on the side displaying two black balls.
