PORT MELBOURNE TO ST KILDA MARINA

Date: Immediate

Previous Notices: 43T, 103T & 107T are referred and cancelled.

Details:

(a) Mariners are advised that the previously unmarked pile approximately 200m west of the St Kilda Marina entrance is now marked as a SOUTH CARDINAL mark.
The position of the pile is approx. 37° 52.329' S, 144° 58.212' E (WGS84).
The pile is lit with characteristics: VQ (6) + LFL 10 S

(b) Mariners are advised that the Isolated Danger pile installed at approx. 37° 51.303' S, 144° 57.338' E remains unlit.

(c) Mariners are advised that three (3) new buoys have been installed within St Kilda Harbour. These buoys are Sealite type SLB1250, CAN shape, yellow without topmark and display alternating 5 Knot and Kiteboard Warning graphics. Their locations are approx. as follows:

37° 51.778' S, 144° 58.135' E
37° 51.675' S, 144° 58.063' E
37° 51.534' S, 144° 57.857' E

These buoys mark the offshore limits of the area of kiteboard activity within the harbour. These buoys are unlit.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of these changes.
