HIGH DEFINITION SCANNING

Date: 15-16 July 2011

Details: Mariners are advised of activities to secure high definition scan data at the HMVS CERBERUS wreck, located at approximately 37° 58.058' S, 145° 0.458' E (WGS84).

The works will be carried out using laser scanning equipment from a jack-up barge which will relocate about the wreck. Several workboats will be in operation.

On-water plant remaining anchored overnight in the vicinity of the wreck will be marked with flashing yellow hazard lights from sunset to sunrise.

Mariners are advised to navigate with extreme caution to and from Black Rock Jetty, particularly within the vicinity of the wreck and the on-water plant and vessels associated with the works.
