SWEEP MAINTENANCE DREDGING WORKS

Date: Effective 16th September 2011 until 23rd September 2011

Former Notice Notice 106(T) 2011 refers and is cancelled

Details: Mariners are advised that sweep maintenance dredging works at No. 5 Yarraville berth have been completed.

Sweep maintenance dredging works will continue at berth No. 6 Yarraville between 0700 hours to 1800 hours Monday to Friday from 16th September 2011 until 23rd September 2011.

The sweeping works, conducted by an excavator mounted on the jackup barge '**JUB2**', may extend up to 30 metres from the berth face.

The jackup barge will be attended by the workboat '**Taurus**' which can be contacted on VHF channel 12 or by mobile phone on 0409 400 722 .

Whilst not engaged in sweeping works the '**JUB2**' and '**Taurus**' will lay-up overnight at No. 5 or No. 6 Yarraville if available.

Mariners are advised to exercise caution when navigating in proximity to the sweeping operations.
