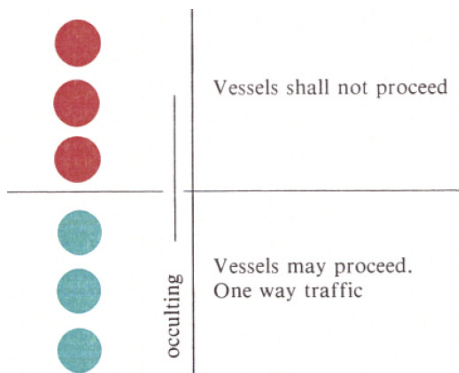

PATTERSON RIVER – WHALERS COVE

REPLACEMENT OF TIDAL GATES AT THE EASTERN CHANNEL TO WHALERS COVE

Date: Immediate to 28 February 2012

Details: Mariners are advised of Melbourne Water works to replace the existing tidal gates at Whalers Cove at approximate location 38° 4.203'S 145° 8.048'E (WGS84).



Navigation through the gates will be reduced to one lane. A traffic light management system will be in place for vessels entering or exiting the lakes at the tide gates between Patterson River and Whalers Cove.

This will consist of three vertical red lights signalling **STOP** and three vertical green lights signalling **GO**.

Mariners are advised to exercise caution when navigating within the vicinity of the works and obey all traffic signals. Floating plant and hazards associated with the construction works will be marked with yellow flashing lights from sunset to sunrise. Buoyage will also be deployed to ensure vessels stay clear of works.
