CLIFTON SPRINGS BOAT HARBOUR - MAINTENANCE DREDGING

Date: Immediate to 10 November 2011

Details: Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging works at Clifton Springs Boat Harbour, by the City of Greater Geelong, at approximate location 38° 9.274'S, 144° 33.209'E (WGS84).

Dredging works in the harbour and access channel will be carried out using a barge mounted excavator and hopper barge. Dredged material will be moved approximately 900m offshore to an area north of the harbour.

All on water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation will be marked with flashing yellow hazard lights from sunset to sunrise.

The boat ramps will be closed to vessels during the works, preventing access to Port Phillip Bay. Launching facilities will be available on weekends, however some restrictions and time delays may apply.

Alternative launching facilities are available at Limeburners Point in Geelong or Point Richards at Portarlington.

All vessel operators are advised to exercise caution and proceed at a safe speed when navigating in the area of the works.
