Mariners are advised of a high speed offshore superboat race on the dates and times nominated above.


The race course on Corio Bay consists of an approx. 10km lap circumference and a diagram of the respective race courses are displayed in this notice for both of the days events


Safety and event marshal vessels will be in place at strategic locations along the course and these vessels will display orange pennants with the wording "Official" on the flag to distinguish them as officiating event marshals. These event marshals and Parks Victoria Authorised Officers will direct non participating vessel operators around the race course.

An event information brochure will be available to mariners at the St Helens and Limeburners Boat Ramp facilities on each day of race activities. This event information brochure can also be obtained from the Australian Offshore Powerboat Club website at www.aopc.com.au and the Parks Victoria Information Centre on 13 1963

Race participants and spectator boats are reminded of their obligations as per the Victorian Regional Channels Authority Harbour Master's Directions to keep a lookout for large ships transiting the Geelong Channels and keep well clear of them at all times without obstructing their passage. The Duty Marine Controller may be contacted on VHF Channel 12 or on 5247 0300 for any clarification regarding large ship traffic on the day.

Mariners are advised to navigate around the event race course and in the vicinity with caution during the times of operation. Race vessels operate at extremely high speeds.
