WAVE RIDER BUOYS – TO BE ESTABLISHED SOUTH OF HOVELL PILE

Date: 21 December 2011.

Details: Mariners are advised that wave rider (monitoring) buoys are to be deployed in the following approximate positions:

- Lat. 38° 20.15' S, Long. 144° 52.78 E in the vicinity of South Channel Bn. No 15
- Lat. 38° 20.12' S, Long. 144° 54.54 E in the vicinity of South Channel Bn. No 19

The buoys are yellow special marks with no top marks displaying light characteristics Fl.Y. 2s.

The mooring system employed to secure the buoys may cause the position of the buoys to vary with wind, tide and weather.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution in the proximity of the buoy. No vessel is to moor at the buoys at any time.
