UPGRADE OF TOORADIN BOAT RAMP INFRASTRUCTURE

Date: Immediate to 26 October 2012

Details: Mariners are advised of upgrade works to Tooradin Boat Ramp infrastructures located at approximate location 38°13.036' S, 145°22.616' E (WGS 84).
The works comprise removal of the existing timber jetty on the western side of the boat ramp, and replacement with a new floating pontoon, as well as relocation of the existing pontoon to the east of the boat ramp a further 3.6 meters.

The works include driving of new piles and installation of floating pontoon units that will be carried out using an on-land excavator.

The vicinity of works will be marked with two yellow buoys with yellow quick flashing lights from sunset to sunrise as per IALA standards.

Mariners are advised to exercise caution when navigating within the vicinity of the works.
