MAINTENANCE DREDGING OF THE ACCESS CHANNEL TO STONY POINT BOAT RAMP

Date: Immediate to 30 September 2012

Details: Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging works of the access channel to the Stony Point boat ramp located approximately in between 38°22.483' S, 145°13.546' E (WGS 84) at the outer limit of the channel and 38°22.470' S, 145°13.364' E (WGS 84) towards the boat ramp.

Dredging works will be carried out by cutter suction dredge, with spoil disposal to be pumped through a discharge pipe to a land based purpose area. The floating pipe will be marked by orange floats.

The dredge and pipeline will remain on the north side of the channel at night. During set up and some stages of work, access to the boat ramp might be disturbed.

On-water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation will be marked with yellow flashing lights from sunset to sunrise as per IALA standards.

Mariners are advised to exercise caution when navigating within the vicinity the works.
