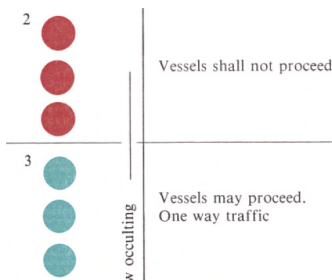

PATTERSON RIVER – WHALERS COVE
REMOVAL OF SUBMERGED CONCRETE STRUCTURE IN WHALERS COVE

Date: Between 10 September 2012 and 12 October 2012

Details: Mariners are advised of Melbourne Water works to remove a submerged concrete structure within Whalers Cove, located near the Whalers Cove West Tidal Gate at approximate location 38° 4.219'S, 145° 8.045'E (WGS84).



During work hours (Monday to Friday, between 7:30am to 6:00pm), navigation will be reduced through Whalers Coves East Tidal Gate. A traffic light management system will be in place for vessels entering or exiting the lakes at the tide gates between Patterson River and Whalers Cove. This will consist of three vertical red lights signalling **STOP** and three vertical green lights signalling **GO**.

Mariners are advised to exercise caution when navigating within the vicinity of the works and obey all traffic signals. On-water plant, equipment or hazards to navigation will be marked to appropriate IALA standards with flashing lights from sunset to sunrise.
