NELSON PIER UPGRADE WORKS COMPLETED – NEW MOORING DOLPHIN
INSTALLED

Date: Effective immediately.

Former Notices 038(T) – 2011 refers and is hereby cancelled.

Details: Mariners are advised that upgrade works at Nelson Pier, including the installation of a new mooring dolphin, have been completed.

The new mooring dolphin is 15 metres in diameter and is positioned approximately 40 metres north east from the end of Nelson Pier. The mooring dolphin is connected to Nelson Pier by a steel pedestrian bridge with height 4 metres above chart datum.

A submarine cable has been installed and runs between the end of the pier and mooring dolphin in line with the pedestrian bridge.

The existing navigational light situated at the end of Nelson Pier (K2347) has now been permanently relocated to the mooring dolphin in position 37° 51.6242' S 144° 54.7888' (WGS84) and retains its original characteristics of F W.

The temporary spotlights required for the upgrade works have been removed.
