MORDIALLOC CREEK
MOUTH TO GOVERNOR RD BOAT RAMP – MAINTENANCE DREDGING

Date: Immediate to 2 November 2012

Details: Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging works by Kingston City Council at Mordialloc Creek at approximate location 38°0.659' S, 145°05.052' E (WGS 84). The dredging area is approximately 920 meters in length and extends from the mouth of the creek to the Governor Rd Boat Ramp.

Dredging works will be carried out using a spud dredge mounted long-reach excavator and transport barges. Shore based excavators and trucks will also be operating.

On-water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation will be marked with flashing lights from sunset to sunrise as per IALA standards.

Mariners are advised to exercise caution and proceed at a safe speed when navigating in the area and observe the displayed day marks on the dredge.
