PORT PHILLIP – WILLIAMSTOWN - ANN STREET PIER –
REHABILITATION WORKS INCLUDING PIER END DEMOLITION

Date: Effective immediately.

Details: Mariners are advised that rehabilitation works at Ann Street Pier including a pier end demolition of approximately 30 metres, will commence on 4 October 2012 and conclude on or about 17 November 2012.

Consequently, the F.G. light at the northern end of the Pier (K2349) has been repositioned to 37° 51' 35.45" S 144° 54' 36.44" E (WSG84), retaining its original characteristics.


Mariners are advised that two temporary hazard buoys have been established in the vicinity of the end of the Pier. Two temporary lanterns have also been positioned marking the northernmost corners of the Pier.

A crane barge with dimensions of 55 metres by 17 metres will be positioned adjacent to the end of the pier for the duration of the works. Further information can be obtained from Oliver Timms, Project Manager Waterway Constructions, on mobile number 0413 264 369.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution in the vicinity of the works.
