**ALTONA BOAT SAFE HARBOUR – CONTINUATION OF MAINTENANCE DREDGING**

**Date:** Immediate to 19 October 2012

**Details:** Mariners are advised of the continuation of maintenance dredging works by Hobsons Bay City Council at Altona Safe Harbour at approximate location 37°52.007' S, 144°50.979' E (WGS 84). Dredging works in the harbour and access channel will be carried out by cutter suction dredge. Dredged material is to be deposited for beach renourishment to the foreshore area at Burns Reserve north east of the harbour.

On-water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation will be marked with yellow flashing lights from sunset to sunrise as per IALA standards.

**Mariners are advised to exercise caution and proceed at a safe speed when navigating in the area and observe the displayed day marks on the dredge.**
