CAPEL SOUND TOOTGAROOK BOAT RAMP - MAINTENANCE DREDGING

Date: 9 November 2012 to 21 November 2012

Details: Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging works by Capel Sound Foreshore Committee at Tootgarook Boat Ramp and subsequent channel at approximate location 38°21.974' S, 144°51.533' E (WGS 84).

Dredging works in the access channel will be carried out by long reach excavator. The boat ramp will be closed to boating while dredge works are undertaken.

Temporary buoys will be deployed to mark the work zone. All plant and equipment will be removed from the water from sunset to sunrise.

Mariners are advised to exercise caution and proceed at a safe speed when navigating within the vicinity of the dredge works.
