**ST KILDA HARBOUR – INNER LOW LANDING - MAINTENANCE DREDGING**

**Date:** 20 November 2012 to approximately 28 November 2012

**Details:** Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging works at the inner low landing at St Kilda Harbour located approximately 37° 51.860' S, 144°58.156' E (WGS 84).  
Dredging works will be carried out by cutter suction dredge, with spoil disposal to be pumped through a discharge pipe to the beach in the vicinity of the sailing school landing and north of the groyne opposite Catani Gardens (Bicentennial Rotunda) at approximate location 37° 51.710' S, 144°58.222' E (WGS 84).

On-water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation will be marked with yellow flashing lights from sunset to sunrise as per IALA standards.

**Mariners are advised to exercise caution when navigating within the vicinity.**
