INSTALLATION OF AIDS TO NAVIGATION

Date: Immediate

Details: Mariners are advised of the **installation of aids to navigation (piles)** at Werribee River entrance; adjacent to Altona Pier and at Williamstown beach as detailed in the following table.

The new aids to navigation mark the offshore extent of the 5 Knot speed limit; No Vessels (swimming only) zones at Williamstown and Altona and a No Swimming zone within the Werribee River.

The piles display retro-reflective banding, retro-reflective topmarks and regulatory signage.

NOTE THE FOLLOWING CHANGE OF AID TO NAVIGATION STATUS:

THE PREVIOUS SPECIAL MARK PILE (at approximate position 37° 58.672' S, 144° 41.670' E) AT THE ENTRY TO WERRIBEE RIVER (lit with characteristics Fl.Y.5s) HAS BEEN CHANGED TO A STARBOARD LATERAL MARK LIT WITH CHARACTERISTICS Fl.G.5s

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of these new and changed aids to navigation.
