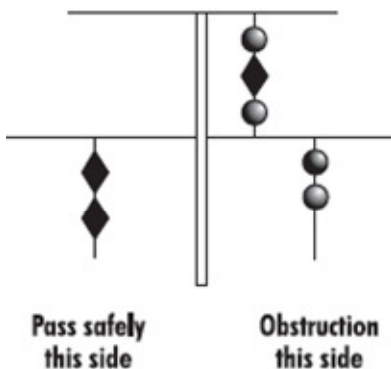

TANKERTON JETTY & CHANNEL MAINTENANCE DREDGING

Date: Immediate

Details: Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging at approximate location 38° 23.001' S, 145° 16.225' E (WGS84).

The dredge will be operating in the channel to Tankerton Jetty. Dredge spoil will be deposited for renourishment of the beach.



During the weekend of December 8 & 9 approximately 140m of pipeline will be anchored outside the channel approximately in line with the northern edge of the channel. This pipeline will be marked with orange buoys.

All on water plant, equipment or potential hazards to navigation will be marked with flashing yellow hazard lights from sunset to sunrise.

All Vessels Operators are advised to proceed at a safe speed and observe the day marks displayed on the dredge.

All vessel operators are requested to pass on the side displaying two diamonds or await instructions before passing on the side displaying two black balls.
