RIVER YARRA – VICTORIA DOCK – REHABILITATION WORKS INCLUDING PARTIAL
WHARF DEMOLITION

Date: 9 July 2013.

Details: Mariners are advised that rehabilitation works at Victoria Dock are scheduled to commence on 9 July 2013, concluding on or about 31 March 2014. Works will include:

- Timber pile, concrete deck and foundation wall rehabilitation at 24 Victoria Dock.
- Demolition of the wharf and repairs to retaining structure at 22 Victoria Dock.
- Steel pile corrosion protection at the Moonee Ponds Creek training wall.

The works will involve persons operating from pontoons and/or barges. Dive activities will be required at various stages throughout the duration of works.


The works will be carried out around shipping movements to and from Victoria Dock.
