PORT PHILLIP - POINT NEPEAN – WRECK ESTABLISHED – EXCLUSION ZONE REMOVED

Date: Effective immediately.

Former Notice 069(T) – 2012 refers and is cancelled.

Details: Mariners are advised that the submerged fishing vessel *Lady Cheryl*, located approximately 500 metres NNE off Point Nepean, has been established as a wreck.


The wreck is positioned in 38° 17.936' S 144° 39.235' E (WSG84) and has a minimum depth of 3.1 metres below chart datum.

Hence the yellow marker buoy and the 50 metre exclusion zone have been removed.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution in the vicinity of the wreck.
