INVERLOCH JETTY

DEMOLITION AND CONSTRUCTION WORKS

DATE: Effective Immediately.

PREVIOUS NOTICE: NTM 103(T) of 2013 refers and is cancelled.

DETAILS: Mariners and Jetty users are advised that partial demolition and new construction works are being undertaken at the Inverloch Jetty.

Works commenced on 22 July 2013 and will last for approximately 12 weeks. Land based and water borne construction equipment, pile driving works barge and tender vessels will be in use.

One lane of the adjacent boat ramp will be temporarily closed for the period of these works.

Access to the jetty will be restricted and there will be occasions when the jetty will be closed.

The Inverloch Jetty Light (Fl.R 5s) and light tower will be temporarily removed and relocated at the completion of the works.

Two yellow light buoys will be established in the vicinity of the jetty to indicate the south eastern and south western limits of the construction works. Both light buoys will exhibit the flash characteristic FL.Y 5s.

The construction barge will be moored with submerged wires attached to anchors and a pile lit with a yellow flashing light. The anchors will be marked with red buoys

Mariners are advised to exercise greater caution in this vicinity.
