

# Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

**Melbourne, 15 August 2013**

**Port of Port Phillip**

**St Helens Boat Ramp Harbour, Corio Bay Geelong**

**Upgrade Works to the Existing Floating Pontoon Infrastructure**

**Date:** 15 - 26 August 2013

**Previous Notice:** 111T – 2013 is referred and cancelled

**Details:** Mariners are advised that due to the current work conditions, the upgrade works by the City of Greater Geelong at St Helens Boat Ramp Harbour at approximate location 38° 7.189' S, 144° 21.577' E (WGS84) would likely commence on 15 August 2013 instead of the previous 19 August 2013 date.

The works include driving three new piles using pile driving barge, replacement of an existing section of plastic pontoon and establishment of a new section of floating concrete pontoons. Access to the boat ramp is expected to be restricted at times to one lane.

On-water plant, equipment or hazards to navigation will be marked to appropriate IALA standards with yellow conical buoys and flashing lights from sunset to sunrise.

**Mariners are advised to navigate with caution (a speed commensurate with safe navigation) when navigating within the vicinity of the works.**
