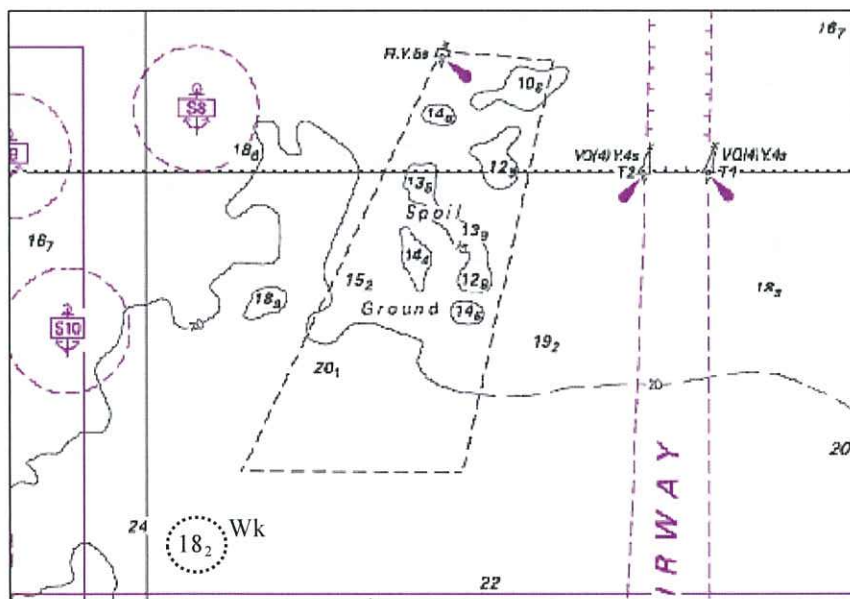

SUBMERGED WRECK IDENTIFIED - SOUTHWEST OF NORTHERN SPOIL GROUND

**Date:** With immediate effect.

**Details:** Mariners are advised that recent surveys conducted in an area southwest of the northern Spoil Ground have identified a submerged wreck in position  $38^{\circ} 03.149' S 144^{\circ} 50.293 E$  (WSG84).




A minimum depth of 18.2 metres exists over the wreck.

**Mariners are advised to navigate with caution in the vicinity of the wreck.**
