

Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

St Kilda Harbour Development Works - Completed

Date: Immediate

Previous Notices: 019(T) – 2013 and 046(T) – 2013 are referred and cancelled.

Details: Mariners are advised that the development works at St Kilda Harbour on the existing breakwater has been completed. The works comprised the construction of a northern and southern rock breakwater to extend the existing breakwater and the installation of 36 new piles configured in two rows next to the kiosk platform.

The new northern rock breakwater is approximately 35 metres in width at seabed and extends from approximate position 37°51.374' S, 144°57.444' E to 37°51.391' S, 144°57.440' E (WGS84).

The new southern rock breakwater is approximately 16 metres in width at seabed and extends from approximate position 37°51.534' S, 144°57.540' E to 37°51.541' S, 144°58.000' E (WGS84).

The 3 temporary landings installed (one on shore and two located at each end of the existing breakwater), the 350 metres temporary land-based groyne and temporary special mark buoys have all been removed. The exclusion zone prohibiting kite surfing within 20 metres either side of the temporary groyne is also no longer in force.

Mariners are advised to exercise caution when navigating within the vicinity.
