RIVER YARRA – PILE EXTRACTION WORKS

Date: 16 October 2013

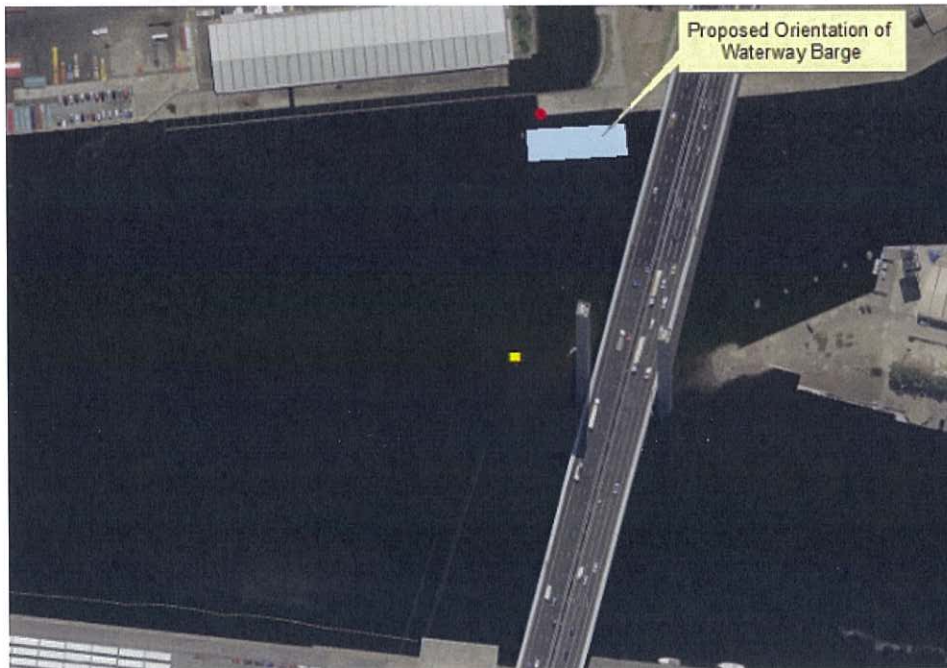
Details: Mariners are advised that extraction works will be undertaken to remove submerged piles in the River Yarra on 16 October 2013.

The works will be undertaken during daylight hours by the Majors Barge (55 m x 18 m) and be attended by 46 motor boat and the vessel *Warneet* and occur in the following two locations:

- 1) $37^{\circ}49.683' S$ $144^{\circ}53.920' E$, off the western bank of the River Yarra approximately 150 metres upstream of the Westgate Bridge:



- 2) $37^{\circ}49.095' \text{ S } 144^{\circ}55.919' \text{ E}$, off the northern bank of the River Yarra approximately 50 m downstream of the Bolte Bridge:



Works will have no impact on commercial shipping movements. Further information can be obtained from Gary Riley, Waterway Construction Supervisor, on 0407 323 007.
