STATION PIER WEST FINGER PIER – HERITAGE CRANE INSTALLATION WORKS

Date: 22 October 2013.

Details: Mariners are advised that works will be undertaken to install the *Stothert & Pitt* heritage listed crane at West Finger Pier and are scheduled to commence on 22 October 2013.

The 147 Barge (55 m x 17 m) will be positioned along the western side of the pier for the duration of the works and will be marked by yellow flashing lights. The vessel *Warneet* and *46 Motor Boat* will be in support, all operations will be conducted during day time hours.

The installation works are scheduled for completion on or around 8 November 2013. Public access to West Finger Pier and use of the low landing will be restricted for the periods during which lifting and assembly of the crane parts are taking place. The works will not impact vessel movements to and from Station Pier.
