

# Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

**Melbourne, 30 October 2013**  
**Australia – Victoria**

**No. 140T - 2013**

**Port of Port Phillip**  
**Patterson River**  
**Installation of New Aids to Navigation - Patterson River**

**Date:** 31 October 2013 to 14 November 2013, weather permitting.

**Details:** Mariners are advised of the installation of 11 new aids to navigation (unlit piles) in an area centred upon the entrance to Patterson River, but extending to the north and to the south. 5 existing piles in close proximity to the scheduled locations will be removed at the time of the works.

Installation will take place in the near shore areas from Chelsea to Carrum, between approx. 38° 3.437' S, 145° 6.757' E and 38° 4.954' S, 145° 7.204' E (WGS 84).

The new aids to navigation are to mark the offshore extent of the new Boating & Swimming Zones, 5 Knot Speed Limits, No Vessels (Swimming Only) Zones and revised navigation marks.

Marine operations plant will include pile driving barge & equipment and support vessels and may include diving operations.

On water plant will be lit to IALA standards from sunset to sunrise.

**Mariners are advised to navigate with extreme caution within the vicinity of the works and the changed aids to navigation.**
