CHANGES TO SHIPS DRAUGHT LIMITS AT CORIO QUAY BERTHS

Date: With immediate effect

Details: Mariners are advised that on the basis of the 2013 bathymetric survey of Corio Quay berths and their approaches, I have increased the maximum limit of the arrival and departure drafts at these berths to 10.5 meters instead of the present 10.40 meters.
The maximum allowable ship length limits at these berths will remain the same. (Please refer below.)
