

# Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

**Installation of New Aids to Navigation & Removal of Redundant Aids to Navigation - Completed**

**Date:** Immediate

**Previous Notices:** 140(T) - 2013 is referred and cancelled.

**Details:** Mariners are advised of the completed installation of 10 new aids to navigation in an area centred upon the entrance to Patterson River.

The new aids to navigation mark the offshore extent of the new Boating & Swimming Zones, 5 Knot Speed Limits, No Vessels (Swimming Only) Zones and revised navigation marks.

The locations (WGS84) of the new aids to navigation **installed** are:

Five (5) redundant aids to navigation in close proximity to the above locations, including the yellow Special Mark pile located at 38°04.460' S & 145°07.064' E, have been **removed**.
