The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Mount Martha to Elwood

Installation of New Aids to Navigation / Removal of Redundant Aids to Navigation

Date: Immediate

Details: Mariners are advised of the installation of new aids to navigation (piles and buoys) and the removal of redundant aids to navigation, along the east coast shore area of Port Phillip from Mount Martha to Elwood between approx. 38°19.111' S, 144°58.706' E and 37°52.878' S, 145°58.309' E.

The installation work areas include:

1. Mount Martha and Safety Beach	10. Mordialloc
2. Fishermans Beach Mornington	11. Mentone
3. Mills Beach Mornington	12. Beaumaris & Ricketts Point
4. Canadian Bay Mount Eliza	13. Half Moon Bay
5. Seaford Pier	14. Sandringham
6. Keast Park & Patterson River	15. Hampton
7. Chelsea	16. Brighton
8. Edithvale	17. Elwood
9. Aspendale	

The new aids to navigation are to mark the offshore extent of the new Boating & Swimming Zones, 5 Knot Speed Limits, No Vessels (Swimming Only) Zones, windsport and water skiing zones, and revised navigation marks.

Marine operations plant will include pile driving barge & equipment and support vessels and may include diving operations.

On water plant will be lit to IALA standards from sunset to sunrise.

Mariners are advised to navigate with extreme caution within the vicinity of the works and the changed aids to navigation.
