The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Half Moon Bay, Black Rock
Works – Removal of Catwalk

Date: Immediate until 10 October 2014, weather permitting.

Previous Notices: 123(T)-2014 is referred.

Details: Mariners are advised of works to be undertaken to remove the catwalk extending from a point adjacent to the Half Moon Bay boat ramp to the jetty, at approximate location 37°58.148'S, 145°00.593'E (WGS84).

The works will incorporate the use of an excavator, positioned on an in-situ sand platform adjacent to the existing catwalk piles.

The works are being undertaken by Bayside City Council to enable the boat ramp to be re-opened in due course.

Mariners are advised to exercise caution within the vicinity of the works and are reminded that the Half Moon Bay boat ramp remains closed until further notice.
