Date: Immediate

Previous Notices: 123(T)-2014, 126(T)-2014 & 169(T)-2014 are referred and cancelled.

Details: Mariners are advised of the completion of works to remove the catwalk adjacent to the Half Moon Bay boat ramp at approximate location 37°58.148'S, 145°00.593'E (WGS84).

Although the public boat ramp has now been re-opened, changes to conditions mean that berthing facilities are no longer available and therefore the facility is no longer suitable for solo operators.

The Black Rock jetty remains closed.

All mariners are advised to exercise caution under the revised conditions at Half Moon Bay, Black Rock.

The North Road, Brighton public boat ramp and jetty remain closed pending assessment by Bayside City Council.
