WEBB DOCK EAST 5 BERTH EXTENSION – CONSTRUCTION WORKS

Date: 28 October 2014

Details: Mariners are advised that construction works to extend the berth at Webb Dock East 5 are scheduled to commence on 28 October 2014.

The works relate to the Maritime Works Package for the Port Capacity Project, as detailed in NTM 071(T)-2014.

Construction is to be undertaken by the following vessels and plant which will remain onsite for the duration of the works:

- 1 x Tug (*Stay Calm*)
- 1 x Jack-up Barge (*JUB – 2*)
- 4 x support vessels (*Angela, Juliet, Romeo & Signet*)
- 7 x pontoons

Operations will be conducted from Monday to Saturday during daylight hours with the works scheduled for completion in June 2015.
