The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

BASS STRAIT – OFFSHORE WESTERN PORT BAY
(PHILLIP ISLAND)
WAVE GAUGE BUOY

Date: 23 October 2014.

Details: The Previous Notice No.152 (P) -2014 is referred and cancelled.

A permanent wave gauge buoy has been established offshore of Western Port Bay (Phillip Island) to assist in the collection of oceanographic data.

The wave gauge buoy will be deployed permanently. This Notice reflects the amended position of the wave gauge buoy.

The wave gauge buoy has the characteristics of a special mark buoy fitted with a radar reflector, and is lit with the characteristics-
Flashing - Yellow 4 seconds. (FI Y 4s 3M).

The buoy will be marked with an identifier- WPO-02.

The buoy has been established in the approximate position:
Lat. -38° 34.61' Long.145°12.65'
WGS84.

Masters of vessel are advised to navigate with caution in the vicinity of the buoy.
