WEBB DOCK EAST 4 STERN RAMP – DEMOLITION WORKS

**Date:** 29 October 2014

**Details:** Mariners are advised that demolition works, including dive activities, are scheduled to commence at Webb Dock East 4 Stern Ramp from 29 October 2014. The works relate to the Maritime Works Package for the Port Capacity Project, as detailed in NTM 071(T)-2014.

Demolition is to be undertaken by the following vessels and plant which will remain onsite for the duration of the works:

- 1 x Tug (*Stay Calm*)
- 4 x support vessels (*Angela, Juliet, Romeo & Signet*)
- 5 x pontoons

Diving activities will be conducted by Professional Diving Services from the vessels *MV Regardless, Pro Diver 2* and *Pro Diver*.

All operations will be conducted from Monday to Saturday during daylight hours and are expected to be completed on or about 10 April 2015. For further information, please contact Melbourne Vessel Traffic Service on VHF Channel 12 or 9644 9700.
