

# Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

**Kananook Creek, Frankston**

**Kananook Creek Mouth - Maintenance Dredging Works**

**Date:** 10 November 2014 to 20 November 2014, weather permitting.

**Previous Notices:** 167(T)-2014 is referred and cancelled.

**Details:** Mariners are advised of maintenance dredging works to be undertaken by Frankston City Council to the Kananook Creek entrance, located approximately at 38°08.765'S, 145°06.932'E (WGS84).

Dredging works will be carried out by a vessel-based sub-dredge with submersible electric slurry pump. Dredged material will be deposited for beach renourishment at the adjacent Frankston beach.

On-water plant, equipment and potential hazards to navigation arising from the works will be marked and lit as per IALA standards. The sub-dredge will be stored when idle in a docking cage pontoon, moored within the Creek.

**Mariners are advised to navigate with caution within the designated speed limit and exercise caution within the vicinity of the works.**
