

Victorian Notice to Mariners

The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Corio Bay, Geelong
Floating Christmas Tree - Deployment Works and Display

Date: Immediate until 5 January 2015.

Details: Mariners are advised of the deployment of a barge to support the Geelong floating Christmas tree at the approximate location (WGS84) 38°08.571'S, 144° 21.763'E, adjacent to Cunningham Pier.

The 25 x 10 metre barge will be moored approximately 40 metres from the Pier and will remain in position until 5 January 2015.

Submerged marine cables will be used to supply power to the tree's lights. The cables will be installed between the barge and the Pier. Three unlit, yellow, pillar-shaped buoys will be used to distinguish the cable route.

The floating Christmas tree will be lit from dusk to dawn.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution and within the designated speed limit within the vicinity of the works and barge.
