TEMPORARY SILT CURTAINS – INSTALLATION PERIOD EXTENDED

Date: 26 November 2014

Notice No. 084(T) – 2014 refers and is cancelled.

Details: Mariners are advised that the installation period for the two silt curtains positioned at the northern end of Webb Dock has been extended. The silt curtains are now scheduled for removal on or about until 30 June 2015.

The first curtain has been installed at the northern head of Webb Dock, enclosing a shoreline of approximately 100 metres and extending up to 30 metres offshore.

The second curtain runs approximately 400 metres in a southerly direction from a position adjacent to the Front Lead Light (37° 50.44' S 144°54.25 E) to a shore based position north of the 2 West Webb Dock pontoon.

The curtains are positioned outside the toe line and marked by flashing yellow buoys and unlit yellow floats.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution in the vicinity of the silt curtains.
